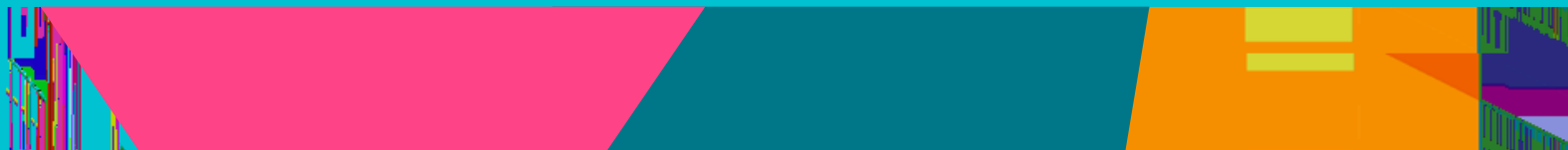






# Title IX, Discrimination, Harassment & Retaliation Office

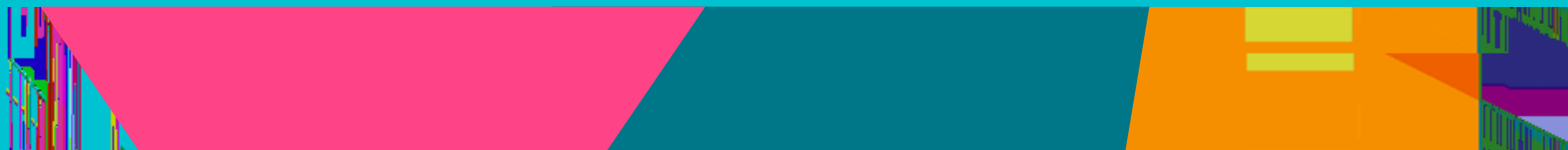

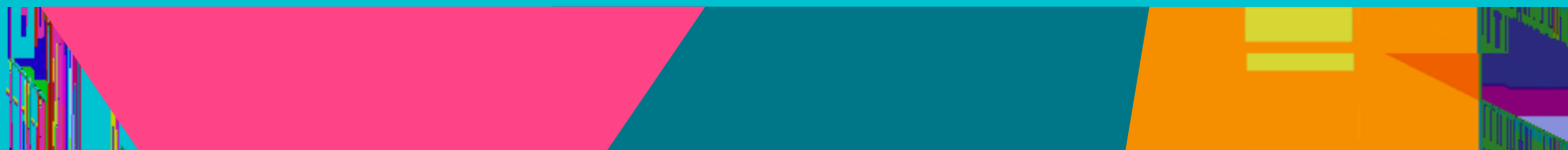
