- o Have and distribute policy against sex discrimination is recommended that the policy make clear that prohibited sex discrimination covers discrimination against pregnant and parenting students.
- o <u>Adopt and publish rejevance procedure</u> for students to file complaints of sex discrimination, including discrimination related to pregnancy or parental status
- o Identify at least one employee in the school or school districtarry out its responsibilities under Title IX (sometimes called <u>aitle IX Coordinator</u> and notifyall students and employees of the name, title and contact information of its Title IX Coordinat <u>and parenting students</u> include overseeing complaints of discrimination against pregnant and parenting students.
